### Portfolio presentations

- Portfolio presentations allowed to publicize the program to the educational community.
- Issues raised by students not only allowed them to be successful in their exams but allowed them also to build life skills.

- On Saturday, July 9, students from two classrooms presented orally their portfolios on two important issues:
- 1. Violence against children
- 2. Load shedding of electricity Kennedy high school is a girls school
